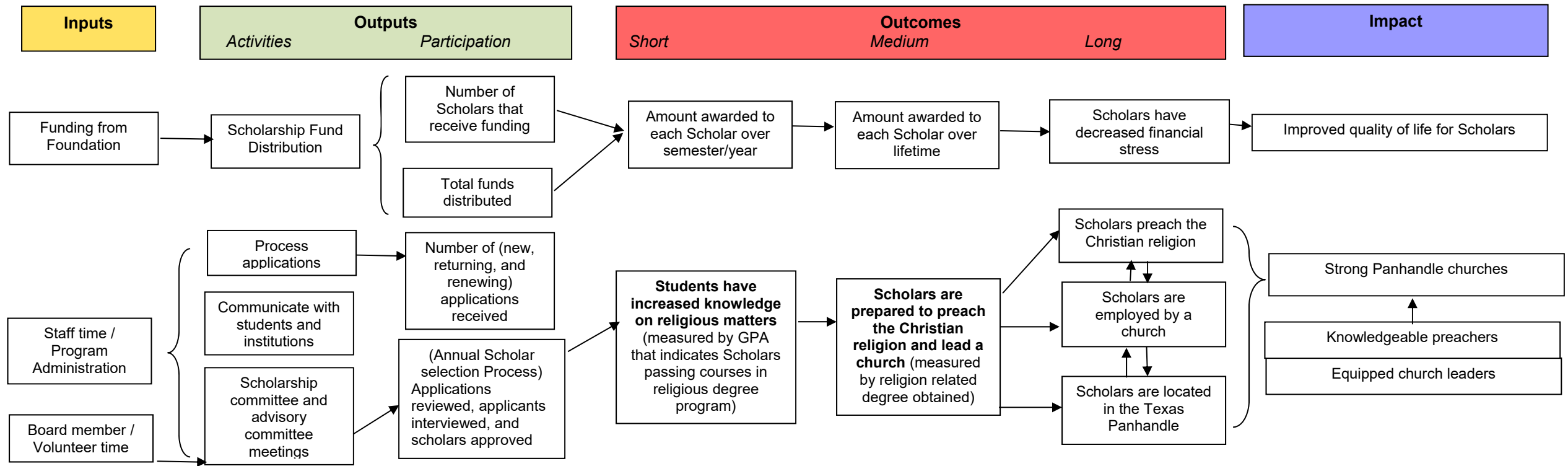


**Program: Mary E. Bivins Foundation Religious Scholarship Program Logic Model**

**Situation:** The Mary E. Bivins Foundation Religious Scholarship Program was established in 1954 to “operate for the benefit of worthy religious undertakings, including the education of ministers to preach the Christian religion”. As stated in the Restated Articles of Incorporation of the Mary E. Bivins Foundation the purpose of the Religious Scholarship Program is to educate ministers to preach the Christian religion. The scholarship program is structured to assist students in obtaining an education that enables them to preach the Christian religion, strengthen the education of those that are currently preaching the Christian religion, or prepare individuals to enter into vocational Christian ministry. The current strategy is to provide juniors and seniors a yearly \$5,000 scholarship, full-time graduate students a yearly \$7,000 scholarship, and full-time ministers attending school part time a yearly \$5,000 scholarship.
