

2020 Healthy Seniors Grant Program Summary of Results

19 grants approved in November 2020 for a total of \$272,350

1. 13 wheelchair ramps were built by the **Texas Ramp Project** to provide safe access to homes for older adults
2. Supported MedFest where 55 **Special Olympics** athletes were given health screenings
3. The **Snack Pak 4 Kids Nutrition 4 Change** program expanded to serve twenty adults from the Wesley Community Center
4. Supported bags of food being delivered to individuals in the Hunger Relief Program of the **Senior Ambassadors Coalition**
5. Supported the **Area Agency on Aging's** FoodNET Program by purchasing 4,705 meals that went to 246 individuals
6. 420 care packages were delivered to seniors living in rural communities by **Panhandle Community Services**
7. Supported the **Salvation Army, ASC Industries, and Ochiltree County Senior Citizens Association**
8. 2,958 free and 317 discounted meals were provided to 37 different residents in Dallam and Hartley counties by **Meals on Wheels of Dalhart**
9. The **Hereford Senior Citizens Association** purchased new ovens, replaced the sinks, and purchased new tables and chairs



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10. 20 senior Shalom patients at **Heal the City** participated in a diabetic-specific food program for a year
11. **Hall County Home Delivered Meals** completed kitchen upgrades including a new mop sink, refrigerator, hot water heater, etc.
12. **GrayCares Living at Home** purchased supplies for 5 handicap accessible wheelchair ramps in Pampa
13. **Garretson Center** built a drive-through on the building, purchased a deep fryer for the kitchen, and purchased groceries to feed senior citizens.
14. **Donley County Senior Citizens Association** used grant funds to purchase food for 9 months – during which 20,810 meals were served
15. Food costs were offset for **Dalhart Senior Citizens Association** who served 14,955 meals during the year
16. Transportation software, training, and drive phone app fees were paid for six months for **CORD Care Transportation**
17. **Collingsworth County Home Delivered Meals** replaced the air conditioner unit and provided breakfast to clients for four months
18. The **Cactus Well Health Center** created and distributed diabetes prevention literature to the community, offered educational seminars, and offered exercise classes. Vaccines were also provided free of charge to older adults.
19. General support of the **Wesley Community Center's** Senior Citizens program which served over 83 individuals in the year
