Calling Essay

Shortly after my conversion, I had a sense of a calling to ministry. When I was much younger, I had expressed a desire to preach like my father, though this was more based on a son's natural inclination to follow his dad than any real sense of calling to preach. But now I began to find that nothing else would satisfy. Nothing else held my attention quite like the ministry. I desired it in earnest. The calling of pastor seemed to me the highest and greatest calling possible. No other vocation would suffice. Beyond the excellence, there was a great delight in seeing that my life would be spent in the service of God's people who I had come to love so dearly as well as serving the Lord in more direct way.

In pursuit of that sense of calling to ministry, I have submitted to preparation through personal effort and study, training through the local church, and education at Midwestern Baptist Theological Seminary, to say nothing of the preparation through my undergraduate degree. Through all of these, I have continued to receive affirmation from friends, ministry leaders, professors, and pastors as to my gifts and calling to the ministry. I am yet committed to continuing my education to better serve the church, which I take both as a personal affirmation by God's providence and external affirmation through institutional approval.

Over the years, that sense of calling has also been affirmed by the local churches I have served at. While I would not yet say that I am completely qualified to assume the office of pastor in a local church, yet I have been in ministry roles for some time. I have realized how much I love to preach and teach. Even what may be considered menial tasks have taken on a certain attractiveness in my eyes if I can be shown how they benefit God's people. I can honestly say I do not think I could ever be satisfied in any other vocation or occupation than to serve as a pastor in a local church. With that calling, I have witnessed in myself a growing fitness for the office of pastor. I pray the Lord will yet be pleased to continue to sanctify me for the calling I believe He has placed upon me.

As to the specific ministry I feel called to, I believe it is either to a senior pastor role or a teaching pastor position. I do not discern that I have the right temperament for youth or children's ministry. While I have been given many gifts, sufficient musical ability for music ministry is not among them. I would not dare to claim the administrative abilities to satisfy the church's need for an administrative pastor. But I do discern the gifts of a preaching/teaching pastor in myself. It is therefore to that specific ministry that I believe I am called.

Logan Britton served with me as a student ministry intern in 2021. During his time as my intern Logan displayed the necessary gifts and abilities to be successful in his calling to be a Pastor.
