Organizations must be eligible applicants, and applications must meet the Foundation's eligibility requirements found on the website www.bivinsfoundation.org. (Scroll over the Grants header and click on Program Overview. "Eligibility Requirements" will be on the right-hand side of the page.) Please note eligibility for the Healthy Seniors Grant Program is not impacted by a request or grant through the Bivins Foundation's normal community grant cycle.

The 2024 Healthy Seniors Grant Program will accept requests between \$2,500 and \$25,000. The application for this program is available on the Mary E.
